Some of the activities offered to students through the Program include:

- 2. American Indian craft classes
- 3. American Indian dance classes
- 4. American Indian drum practice
- 5. Classroom presentations
- 6. School-wide presentations
- 7. Field trips
- 8. Quarterly newscard
- 9. Pow Wow, special events and other Cultural workshops
- 10. Help in choosing a college or other continuing education program
- 11. Help in finding financial aid for college
- 12. Referral service for other Indian activities and events
- 13. Help with researching Tribal Ancestry
- 14. High School Units in Fine Arts or Electives

If your child is of American Indian decent, they may be qualified to be enrolled in the Program. If you do not know if your child qualifies for our Program, but feel as though they might, our staff will assist you in securing your documentation.


You are not obligated to participate in any of the activities after your child is enrolled; but we encourage you and your family to participate.
