Please submit two letters of recommendation, giving information about your character, ability to achieve the educational goal, ambition, and financial needs. Letters from the principal, vice principal, attendance supervisor, counselor or teacher are preferred. Letters need to be signed and dated.

**TRANSCRIPT**

Include a copy of your high school transcripts or college transcripts (if a returning student)

**ESSAY**

Type (font size 12, double spaced) or write legibly an essay regarding your educational and career goals. Include reasons for your choice of school, area of major and a statement of how any scholarship funds received would be used in reaching your stated goals. Clearly state your personal financial responsibility and your family's ability to assist financially in your education. 500 words maximum. Be concise and thorough. List any other financial aid you are receiving.

**PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE** to a 2- or 4- year college/university or career training program.

**RESUME**

Including all extracurricular and co-curricular activities for the past 4 years, broken down by year. Include employment, community service, sports, awards, and leadership positions. Include the number of hours/days served for volunteer work and or employment.
