Eligibility:

Applicants must be a graduating senior of Sutter Union High School, have obtained, or will be obtaining, at least one varsity letter in Sutter Union High School sports, and have an overall grade point average of at least 3.0. Verification of enrollment in an appropriate institution is required to receive award disbursement of scholarship funds.

Transcripts:

The applicant is responsible for providing certified high school transcripts.

Letters of Recommendation:

Three (3) letters of recommendation are required to be submitted with the application. Letters of recommendation must be obtained from the following sources: a current/former high school coach, a current/former high school teacher, and an outside source (not an employee of Sutter Union High School District).

Notification:

The SHASA board will review all applications and final notification of the recipient will be made prior to the Senior Scholarship Awards Night.
